

Wee Ma Tuk Traer Lake

8 acres

50-60 years old

Max Depth 14'

Large watershed, heavy flow in and out

Very turbid water

Little vegetation present

Channel Catfish naturally reproducing

Few walleye

Largemouth Bass, Bluegill, Crappie population rated fair for size and numbers

Fishing has been improving the past few years

Lots of grass carp stocked in the past, but starting to thin down

Based on our observations and conversations here are our recommendations for this lake:

- Encourage harvest of channel catfish as much as possible
- Stock 100 black crappie 5-7" every fall. These fish cost \$1.45 each with \$25 delivery
- Stock 100 bluegill 4-6" every fall. These fish cost \$1.45 each with \$25 delivery
- Stock 50 largemouth bass 5-8" every fall. These fish cost \$2.40 each with \$25 delivery
- Stock 30 walleye 5-8" every fall. These fish cost \$2.40 each with \$25 delivery
- Consider stocking just a handful of grass carp every couple years. They cost \$10.50 each plus \$25 delivery.
- Daily limit would be 3 largemouth bass under 14", release all over 14"
- Keep 25 bluegill and 10 crappie per day for next 3 years

- Add a few brush piles every year.
- The stocking plan is to help diversify genetics and get the pond in a better balance with some bigger fish of each
